Photography is permitted without fee for all purposes in the park, except where park participation, resources or facilities use is deemed necessary by the Park Manager, in which cases this Permit is necessary for photography in the park. During park hours from 8:00 a.m. to sunset, the permit fee is \$75.00 per day, plus all applicable entrance fees. The after-hours permit fee is \$100.00 per day, plus all applicable entrance fees. The after-hours fee includes normal, open hours on the same day for which the after-hours fee has been paid. When used for TV Program and Motion Picture filming, permit fees will be negotiated in advance. Permit fees are payable on or before arrival at the park. Permittee may elect to pay entrance fees each day when entering the park.

To ensure appropriate coordination, Permittee must notify the park in advance of the locations, times and any special arrangements for each planned use of this permit. The exact location, within the park, for photography or filming must satisfy the Park Manager. If agreement cannot be reached, the Park Manager may deny or revoke this Permit. Refunds will be prorated for days already used.

Park management, at their discretion, may require the Permittee to furnish a guard at the Permittee's expense. People serving as guards are subject to Park Manager's approval. The Permittee will replace the guard at the request of the Park Manager.

Permittee will furnish documentation that commercial operation is covered by a current liability insurance policy with a minimum of \$300,000 combined single limit coverage, showing the Division and the Park as additionally insured, to be attached to the park's copy of this form and incorporated by reference as exhibit B. Permittee assumes all risks in this operation and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State of Florida, its officers and employees from every claim, suit, loss, damage or injury arising out of any operations under this Permit.

If additional specific terms and conditions are required, they will be stated in a Location Agreement and attached to this form and incorporated by reference as Exhibit C.

Exhibit A

Guidelines for TV and Motion Picture Filming

TV and Motion picture companies will be allowed to film on state park property subject to the following restrictions:

1. The Park Manager will authorize permits for TV and motion picture filming.
2. Fees for TV and motion picture filming will be negotiated in advance.
3. The Division of Recreation and Parks will be reimbursed for any expenses it incurs above normal coordination and monitoring of activities.
4. The Permittee will insure that all park resources and facilities remain in their pre-permit condition during the filming process. The Division will be reimbursed for the cost of any repairs incurred as a result of damage to facilities or resources caused by the filming activities.
5. Park resources and/or facilities will not be altered in any way which would change established resource management schedules or practices, cause permanent damage, shorten the useful life, or reduce the effectiveness or quality of such resources or facilities.
 - a. Adequate safeguards will be implemented to ensure that all animals or plants brought into the park for filming are removed from the park at the conclusion of the permit period.
 - b. No pruning, cutting or breaking of vegetation is permitted.
 - c. No digging, scraping, or other soil disturbance is permitted.
6. When filming requires the exclusion of park visitors from a park use area, the filming time must be approved by the Park Manager and the duration will be kept to a minimum.
7. Security of the set or filming location will be the responsibility of the Permittee.
